General Information

Tickets:

Admittance to STAND UP 2013 is by ticket only. Tickets will be mailed to you as soon as all registration materials are received. Anyone planning to attend must register. Youth must attend the event as part of a school or organization's team. Tickets are limited and available on a first come, first serve basis.

The event is **FREE** of charge.

Step 1

Reserve Your Space

Step 2

Team Registration Form

Step 3

Participant Permission Form

Please copy and distribute a Participant Permission Form to each participant (students and adults). Both signatures (if student is under 18) are required for students to attend. Please Note: adults are also required to complete forms. Forms for all team members should be in one package and mailed to The Rendon Group or emailed to kari@standuptobullying.org. Forms must be received by Friday, November 1, 2013.

Step 4

Event Tickets Are Mailed

Once we receive your Team Registration Form and all Participant Permission forms, event tickets will be mailed to you along with additional event information, including directions and bus/van information. Tickets will be assigned as registration packets are received. The earlier you register and send in your materials, the better your team's seats will be.

Who Is Eligible?

All middle and high school students from public, private, charter, collaborative or parochial schools in New Hampshire. Student organizations are also eligible to submit nominations.

How do we apply?

All activities completed since September 2012 through November 2013 and all activities planned throughout June of 2014 are eligible. If you have supporting materials (flyers, links for videos that have been produced, handouts, photos, etc.) that you would like to include in your application, please feel free to do so.

What is the criteria?

We are interested in all of the activities, programs, events, projects and curriculum that you have developed and implemented in your school or organization since September 2012 through November 2013, as well as everything you have planned through June of 2014. The activities that will be considered for this award should incorporate one or more of the following:

- to provide an understanding of bullying and the harm it inflicts upon individuals and society;
- to recognize bullying and take personal responsibilities for combating bullying;
- · to provide techniques for combating bullying in your school and community; and
- to identify factors in the school environment which promote intergroup understanding, anti-bullying and student successes.
